Australian Clay Mineral Society Conference 2014

The conference will consist of two days of voluntary paper presentations followed by a field trip. There will be a visit to inspect the advanced electron-optical equipment at the WA Centre for Microscopy and Microanalyses. Time will also be available to visit the adjacent Swan River, Kings Park and campus museum and art gallery.



The field trip on the 5th February will visit a bauxite mine in the Darling Range where deep regolith, mineral extraction and jarrah forest rehabilitation will be examined. Bauxite refining will also be viewed. After an 'al fresco' lunch we will visit a mineral sands mine near Capel to view the geology of strandline deposits, extraction of heavy minerals and rehabilitation of mines back to productive pasture. A synthetic rutile plant will be visited where partly altered ilmenite grains are converted to porous rutile prior to further refining.



We will then visit Bunbury en route to Perth where delegates attending the Australian Regolith Geoscientists Association meeting can be delivered to their hotel.

There will be a conference dinner on the evening of 4th February at the prestigious University Club on the Swan River. West Australian wines and foods will be featured on the menu.



Accommodation has been reserved for 4 nights (nights of 2nd – 5th February inclusive) in 25 ensuite rooms (with a double bed at \$75 per night includes breakfast). Please complete the attached booking form to reserve a room, there is a limited number of rooms available which will be assigned



on a first in first served basis. This accommodation is extremely cheap for Perth and conveniently located adjacent to UWA and the conference venue. There are no hotels near UWA and the close set city hotels will be prohibitively expensive for many participants. Please book Trinity College accommodation through the Society and not through the College Office.

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Papers on every aspect of clay science are invited and it is anticipated that applications of clay science to mineral exploration/ processing and oil/ gas exploration/ extraction will be a particular feature of a WA conference.

Submission of papers

It is intended that all participants will have the opportunity to make an oral presentation(s) of 20-30 minutes. A power point projector with screen will be available. Posters in standard format can be presented if preferred.

All presentations will be included in a book of extended papers (4 pages) to be available at the conference. These papers will be lightly reviewed and edited; instructions for their format are attached. **DEADLINE FOR PAPERS is 2nd December 2013.**

Students attending the conference

Students who submit a paper for oral presentation do not pay the full registration cost. Please send a copy of your current student card when submitting your presentation title. A limited number of bursaries are available to students to assist with the cost of attending the conference. These will pay for the registration, field trip and will contribute to the cost of travel. The bursaries will be awarded on the basis of the excellence of the submitted paper.
